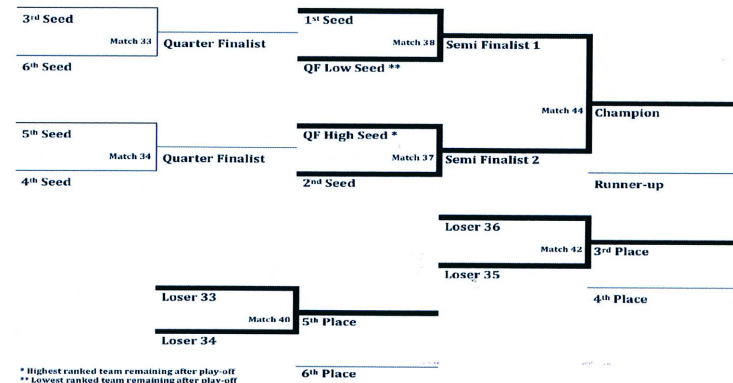

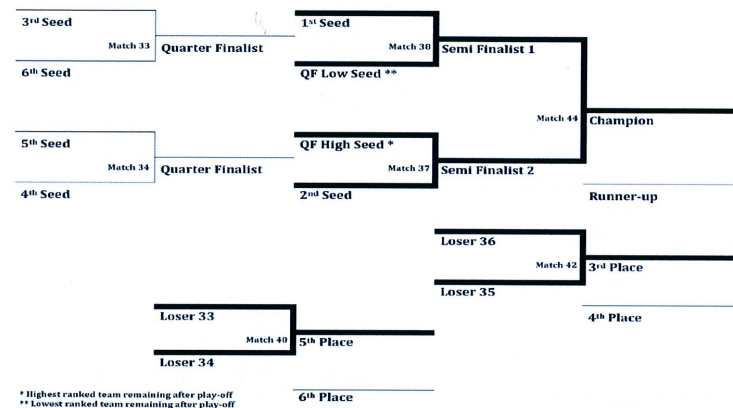

# BADMINTON RULES

## I. RULES

### A. Rule Book:

BWF (latest edition)

### B. Meet Rules:

1. Each team match will consist of 3 singles and 2 doubles, with the winning team decided by the best of 5 matches. All matches must be played.
  2. Players must be ranked according to ability for singles and doubles #1, #2, and #3. Number #1 ranking being the top player. Line-ups will be given to the Site Director at the start of each match and cannot be changed during the match.
  3. The #1 ranked players from each school will play each other, the #2 ranked players will play each other and the #3 ranked players will play each other in the round robin. Once a player or doubles team has been assigned a ranking, he/she cannot change the ranking during the tournament.
  4. The 8th player substitute will play exhibition matches. The 8th player may substitute into the tournament at any position if a player is unable to participate. If a player is replaced, they can take no further part in the tournament. No player can substitute during a match. No players can switch ranking once the tournament has started. To qualify for all-tournament a player must participate in all five matches. The 8th player (alternate) with the best won-loss record should achieve All-Tournament recognition and a chevron. The 8th player will be eligible to play at either #3 singles or the #2 doubles position, as a "free switch" during the tournament. At such a switch, the original #3 singles or #3 doubles person would play in the Alternate match and the #8 player will play in the new position. Only the originally designated 8th player is eligible to play in any of the 3 mentioned positions. If the original 8th person is used because of an injury, at any position, the "free switch" is no longer possible, since they must play in that position for the remainder of the tournament. No All-Tournament Award can be awarded to a position that has been substituted in singles or doubles as a free switch.
  5. The tournament will be run on a round-robin format. In the round robin matches, the first two games will be played first to 21 points (capped, no need to win by two points). The third game will also be capped to 21 points but must be won by two points with a cap of 30. The round-robin league standing of the teams will be determined by their win-loss record with all teams advancing to a post section play, see VIII. POST SECTION PLAY. In case of a tie following the round-robin play, rules under IX. THE BREAKER FOR LEAGUE STANDING will apply. The post section matches will be played as usual to 21 points (win by two points, cap of 30).
  6. There will be a ten-minute warm-up before each match.
  7. Players will call their own lines and keep score.
  8. Players must report to the main desk before the start of their match.
  9. A player reporting more than fifteen (15) minutes after the scheduled match will be declared a walk over.
  10. Coaches will be allowed to consult with their players for 60 seconds during each game when the leading scorer reaches 11 points and between sets. Coaches will not be allowed on the courts for consultation unless there is no outside access.
- Order of play will be as follows:
- a. #3 Singles
  - b. #2 Doubles
  - c. Alternates
  - d. #2 Singles
  - e. #1 Doubles
  - f. #1 Singles
- Please note that whenever possible matches a, b and c should be played concurrently on three courts followed by matches d, e and f.

12. In the event of an injury during a match, only one 5-minute injury time for treatment will be allowed for the duration of that match to determine if the player can continue. The Site Director should monitor the situation.
13. The right to towel-off and/or drink during a match can only be initiated by the serving team.
14. When illegal serves are not contested by the opposing player, the coach of the opposing player is allowed to summon the official to the court for review. The official will inform the player of serving error(s) for player correction. This would be an exception to BWF rules and become an IASAS rule.

## II. UNIFORMS

When illegal Each member of the team will wear the same uniform for the entire match. No tank tops are allowed and uniform must be of school colors.

## III. PROTESTS

All protests are to go through the Tournament Director or the Convention Director. (see section 1.8 XV11).

## IV. POST SECTION PLAY:

- After the round-robin league play, the 4th and 5th place teams and the 3rd and 6th place teams will participate in play-offs seeding matches.
- After these matches (matches 16-19 see section XII) the standings will be reseeded for the play-off games on day 3.
- On the morning of day 3, the 1st and 4th place teams and the 2nd and 3rd place teams will play in semi-final matches (matches 20-23).
- There will be post section play for the 5th and 6th ranked teams (matches 24 & 25).
- The losers of match 20-23 play a consolation match for 3rd place (matches 26 & 27).
- The winners of matches 20-23 will play a championship match to decide 1st & 2nd place (matches 28 & 29).

Rounds 16-19 for both boys and girls - the highest seed will play in the premier facility - each gender 4&4, 3&6 will play at the same time. The order reflect the profiled gender.

## V. THE BREAKER FOR LEAGUE STANDINGS

**A. Head to Head** - (Definition of Head to Head can be found in Section L of Convention Organization). If after L.3 teams are still tied, go to B.

### B. Match Difference (for three or more tied teams):

1. Add the total matches won and the total matches lost of each team involved against each of the other tied teams and subtract. Then rank the teams according to their positive points scored. If still tied, go to 2.
2. Get the match difference of all the matches played of the teams involved in the tie. If still tied, go to C.

### C. SET DIFFERENCE

Add the total games won and the total games lost of each team involved against each of the other tied teams and subtract. Then rank the teams according to their positive points scored. If still tied, go to 2.

### D. POINT DIFFERENCE

1. Add the total points scored and the total points scored against each team involved against each of the other tied teams and subtract. Then rank teams according to their positive points scored. If still tied, go to 2.
2. Add the total points scored and the total points scored against of all the matches played by each of the teams involved in the tie and subtract. To decide the placing, teams will be placed according to the highest positive points gained.

# SOFTBALL RULES

## 1. RULES

### A. Rule Book:

ASA Official Rules of Softball (Amateur Softball Association).

### B. Ground Rules:

The Tournament will be governed by ground rules as instituted by the host school. Games will be scheduled at 1 hour 45 minutes with the understanding that game times are approximate. In fact, subsequent games will start 15 minutes after the conclusion of the previous game.

### C. General Rules:

- The team designated as 'home team' in the finals will be the team with the highest ranking after the round robin including the mini-series if one is necessary. In the case of identical records, head to head will determine the home team. If they have not played, a coin toss will decide.
- Bats that are approved by the ASA June 1st each year can be used for the following 12 months.
- Teams must play all five rounds of the Round Robin even if the last game is a repeat of the Championship Game.
- IASAS Softball is designated as a Class B Division and will follow the ASA Rules governing Class B, especially as they relate to home run limits.

## II. RULE EXCEPTIONS

- A team may play with a minimum of nine (9) players instead of ten (10) players before forfeiting the game.
- A game will be called when the home team has a 15 run lead after 4 1/2 innings with the home team coming to bat.
- A pitching strike zone mat will be employed. The strike mat will be considered as home plate when a player is coming in to score.
- The strike zone mat will be a 22 inches wide, 30 inches long and will be placed such that it will cover and be flush with the front of home plate. The mat should be made of a rubber substance, for safety reasons.
- No new inning may start after one hour and 30 minutes during preliminary rounds providing the game is regulation. Tie games will be continued using the individual game tie-breaker rule until a winner is determined. Championship games only will consist of seven innings or until a tie is broken with no time limit. Consolation games will follow the same tie-breaking procedures as round robin.
- The individual game tie breaker will be employed starting at the end of the regulation game, each offensive team will start with a runner on second base. This runner will be the player due to bat 10<sup>th</sup> in the innings (for 11<sup>th</sup> if an EP is used).
- There will be an extra safety base at the first base on both field.
- When games are modified such that each batter starts with a 1-1 count, a third strike foul will count as a strikeout upon the second foul ball after the count has reached strike two.
- Coaches have the option to bat all 12 players on the Roster.

J. The ball must be delivered with perceptible arc and reach a height of at least six feet from the ground, while not exceeding a maximum height of twelve feet from the ground.

### SPECIAL EQUIPMENT

Helmets are required for all IASAS Softball games.

### THE BREAKING FOR ROUND-ROBIN RANKING

When there is a tie in the ranking list and three or more teams are involved and the tie cannot be broken under the head to head format (see "Resolution of a Tie" in the general rules section) e.g. each team has one win and one loss under a three team head to head series wherein they will play a game against each other team involved in a tie. These games will be called playoff games and teams will draw for identification purposes i.e. Team A, Team B, Team C, etc. (see draw below).

### PLAYOFF GAMES

- Will consist of one inning of normal play.
  - Should two teams be tied after the one inning, they will continue to play extra innings until a decision is reached.
  - Each inning will start with the 10th scheduled batter (11th using an EP) for that inning starting on second base. After the playoff round robin, the team with the most wins will be ranked highest and so on.
- If all the teams are still tied, then the playoff series will be replayed and the entire procedure repeated. However, the order of games and designation of Home Team will change according to the following matrix.

### POST SECTION PLAY

After the round-robin league play, the top two seeded teams will play a championship game to decide 1st and 2nd place.

The 3rd and 4th ranked teams will play for the bronze medal.

There will be no post section play for the 5th and 6th ranked teams.

It is recommended that Championship Games should not be played concurrently. If a Championship game is scheduled at a given time, but the previous game runs over time, the start of the next Championship game will be delayed. (However, the Tournament Director has the right to moderate the schedule if the weather or fading light become factor).
