RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION IN IASAS EVENTS AND SCHOOL-SPONSORED ACTIVITIES INVOLVING TRAVELING OR HOSTING

1. Use or possession of tobacco (including smokeless), alcohol, and/or drugs, flagrant curfew violations*, violent behavior, violations of off-limits areas, cheating, deceit, as well as aiding and/or abetting in any of the listed offenses will not be permitted during any IASAS event. Penalties for infractions are as follows:
 - a. The student will be immediately suspended from further participation in the event.
 - b. The student will be sent home, if feasible.
 - c. The student will be excluded from all IASAS events or exchanges at ISKL or at other IASAS schools for one full year from the date of infraction, including the same tournament/convention the following school year.
 - d. The student will not be eligible to receive letters or awards for that activity. A violation will also preclude a student from receiving any other activity or athletic awards.
2. Off-limits areas include any establishments that sell alcoholic beverages or areas of a city otherwise designated as off limits by the host school.
3. Exploration of the local environment will not be permitted without the knowledge and consent of the host parent/guardian.
4. Housing assignments may only be changed by a school's AD.
5. Daily curfews for all IASAS events will be determined by the host school. All tournament/convention participants (hosting or visiting) must return to the host family's house before the stated curfew each night. However, should an event finish later than one hour before the stated curfew, curfew will be extended until one hour after the conclusion of the event.
6. Coaches will telephone each student each night at the curfew hour to ensure all students have returned home safely and timely. Once a student has returned home and answered the curfew call, **he/she may not leave the house.**
7. All laws of the host country must be observed. Guidelines are to be provided by host schools as required.
8. Any problems arising during the tournament/convention should be reported immediately to the host school for corrective measures.
9. All participants are required to attend all events officially affiliated with the tournament/convention, including special evening events.

For athletic/activity exchange participants, the penalties will also include removal from the team/group for the remainder of the season.

***The following set of criteria will be used to determine a flagrant curfew violation:**

1. Evidence indicating student's lack of an honest attempt to reach home by the stated curfew.
2. The length of time the student was out beyond the curfew (1 hour or more).
3. Whether the student was involved in deceptive action, such as leaving home after the curfew.
4. Violations involving being in off-limits areas, or the use of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs.

I. RULES

- C. The official ball is the Wilson Jet, Wide Channel. (10/02)

II. RULE EXCEPTION

- A. Recommended uniform numbers for IASAS will be 1– 15, 21-25 (10/03).
- B. There will be no dunking during warm-up time before the games. The penalty will be a technical foul, with two shots awarded to the opposing team. (5/96)
- C. Half-time breaks will be 10 minutes. (4/03)

III. ROSTERS

Rosters (up to ten boys and ten girls) must be submitted two weeks prior to the tournament and include the following information:

IV. ENTRIES

V. SUBSTITUTION

As allowed under F.I.B.A. rules.

VI. FACILITIES

Two basketball courts are required. Both teams should have their pre-game warm-up in front of their opponent's (05/06) bench, and the home team will face the clock in the second half. (5/96)

VII. SPECIAL EQUIPMENT

As specified in F.I.B.A. rules. Exception: A smaller women's basketball will be used for all IASAS women's tournament games. (5/93)

VIII. UNIFORMS

All teams must have light and dark uniforms. Numbers on **front and back** with plain numbers, of a solid color contrasting with the color of the shirt. Numbers on back shall be at least 20cm high. Numbers on front shall be at least 10 cm high. The numbers shall be at least 2 cm wide. (10/06)

IX. OFFICIALS

- A. The number and source of officials is to be determined by the host school. Whenever possible, the host school should utilize host country international sporting organizations to officiate tournaments.
- B. Translation services will need to be provided to ensure effective communication between host country and English speakers. (10/01)
- C. The official scorer must be an adult. (10/01)

X. TIE BREAKER

Tie-breaker as stipulated in the F.I.B.A. rules.

XI. PROTEST

See "Protest", section XVII of "Organizations and General Regulations", in handbook.

III. POST SELECTION PLAY

After the round-robin league play, the top two seeded teams will play a championship match to decide 1st and 2nd place.

The 3rd and 4th ranked teams will play for 3rd place.

There will be no post section play for the 5th and 6th ranked teams.

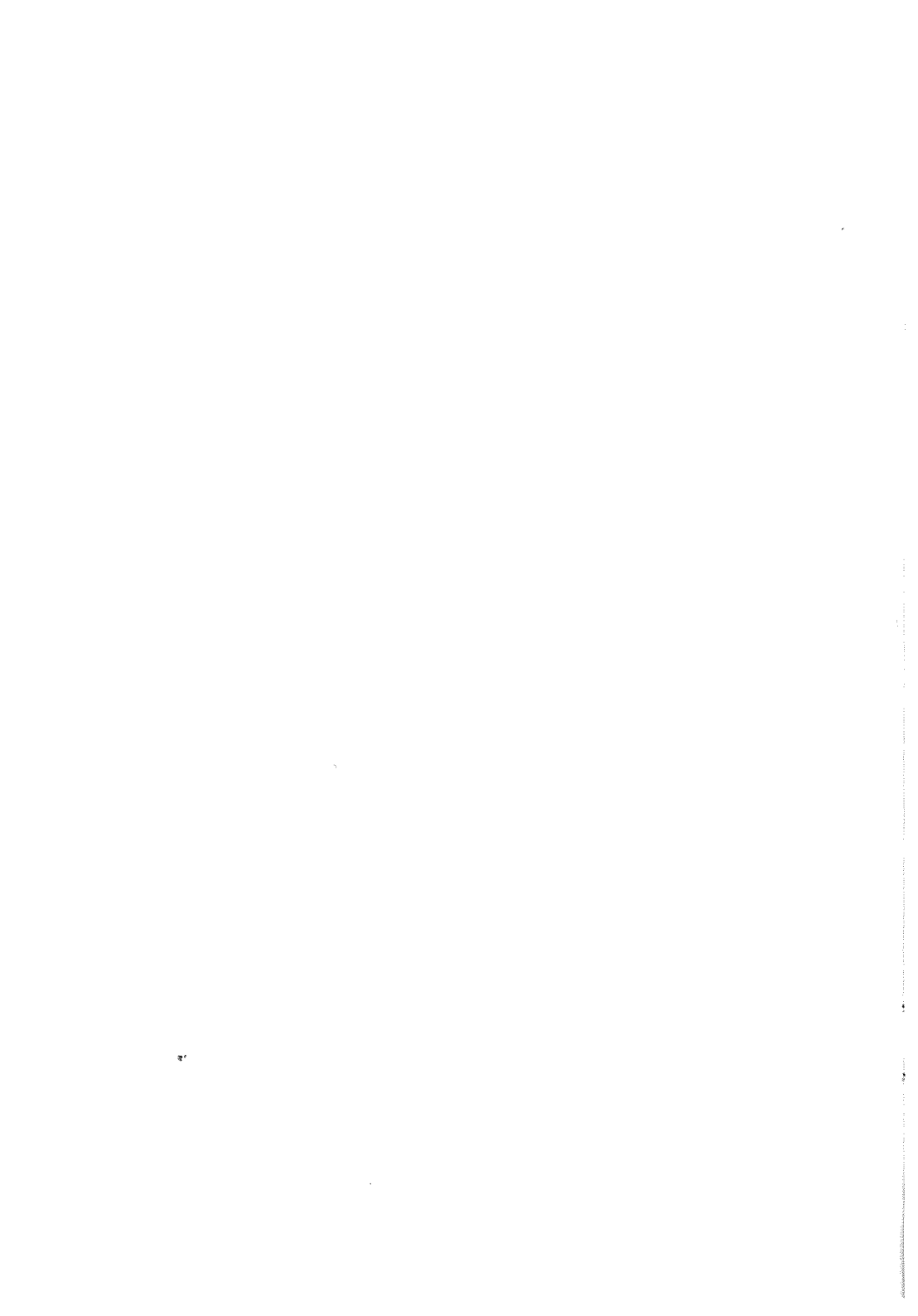
