May this week be a true celebration of your talents and passion!





Death of a Salesman by Athur Miller



DEATH OF A SALESMAN BY ARTHUR MILLER IS REGARDED AS ONE THE GREATEST PLAYS EVER WRITTEN IN THE 20TH CENTURY. DUE TO THE STRENGTH OF CHARACTERS, RELATIONSHIPS AND STORY, IT IS TIMELESS. IT IS ABOUT A MAN THAT FEELS IGNORED AND FORGOTTEN BY SOCIETY AND HIS REGRETS BECOME TOO MUCH TO HANDLE. WE AS ONLOOKERS, GET TO WITNESS THE LAST GASP OF WILLY LOMAN'S LIFE AS HIS FAMILY DESPERATELY TRY TO CONNECT WITH EACH OTHER.

BACK IN OCTOBER, OUR CAST TOOK ON THE MAMMOTH TASK OF DISSECTING, ADAPTING, AND RE-WRITING THIS PLAY INTO A 45 MINUTE FILM. WE WANTED THE FILM TO RETAIN A "LIVE STAGE" FEEL AND SO ALL THE SCENE LOCATIONS ARE ON OUR MAIN-STAGE. WERE WERE FORTUNATE TO COLLABORATE WITH A PROFESSIONAL FILM COMPANY UNDER THE DIRECTION OF WILLIAM LU IN CONJUNCTION WITH A TAS FILM STUDENT- GUSTOVO VERA. OUR STAGE MANAGERS, ISABEL WANG AND RAJI RAMANATHAN, WERE ROCK STARS! A MASSIVE THANK YOU TO KARI JENSEN FOR COSTUME DESIGN, KEVIN HELD FOR SET DESIGN, CHRIS BRYANT FOR PROP DESIGN, AND JESSICA HUANG AND JOAN HO FOR MAKE-UP, POSTER, COMMUNICATIONS. THIS WAS A MONUMENTAL STUDENT-TEACHER-ARTIST COLLABORATION WITH THE UNIFIED VISION OF TELLING AN IMPORTANT STORY AND I CANNOT BE MORE PROUD.



DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Emotional baggage is a term sometimes used to describe the phenomenon of carrying past trauma or so-called negative experiences through life, relationships, or a career. We can see this reflected in someone's posture as if they're carrying around an unbearable weight. Emotional Baggage by Lindsay Price is a pantomime show which requires students to work on the act of showing or explaining something through movements of the body instead of by talking. Our show could have used theatrical masks, such as Trestle Theatre Masks, to portray our characters but really, what's more telling to define our emotional baggage right now than to use our relegated Covid face masks that are our emotional baggage now? In this play we see seven strangers meet in an airport. Instead of hand luggage, they all carry their "emotional baggage." They are forced to confront themselves and one another. Everybody carries emotional baggage with them. What's yours?


