AUDIENCE GUIDELINES

Below are a few guidelines, which audience members need to keep in mind;

Do not enter a room during a speech. Wait politely outside the room until the speaker has finished, then enter. Please cooperate with the door guards. They are there to ensure that the rules of the convention are upheld and that nothing occurs to disturb the presentation.

Please be an appreciative audience. Remember how difficult it is to speak in front of a group. Be polite by not make distracting noises or movements

Entering the room, theatre or auditorium after presentation has begun is not permitted. You must wait and the door guard will be able to assist you in entering at the appropriate time.

In the event that you are watching Impromptu, please be aware that you can enter the room between speakers, but you cannot exit the room until all the speakers have spoken. In impromptu speaking, the topics are secret and once you enter a room you must remain until the entire round has been completed.

DEFINITIONS

Debate

Debate is a regulated, timed discussion of a proposition. Two teams of three students each prepare for their argument by collecting quotes and other evidence from their own sources to defend their ideas, propositions or opposition on a given proposition. Speeches last for eight minutes each and alternate from proposition to opposition. After each speaker has spoken once, both teams are given a four minute reply speech. The proposition is determined by the IASAS committee.

Forensics

Forensics is the term used to describe the four speaking events that along with debate form the competitive elements of Cultural Convention. During the convention, each speaker is identified by a number and must participate in a minimum of three rounds. In these preliminary rounds, each speaker is adjudicated by three judges, and on the basis of ranking achieved in each preliminary round, a group of six speakers per event advances to the finals.

Extemporaneous Speaking

Extemporaneous speaking is the category where the speaker is given a choice of two questions on current events. The speaker has 30 minutes to prepare a speech to answer one of the questions. The speech must be 5-7 minutes in length.

Impromptu Speaking

Impromptu is the category where the speaker has 1 minute to prepare a 3-5 minute speech on one of the two topics provided.

Oral Interpretation

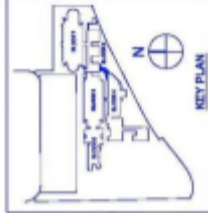
Oral interpretation of literature involves a work of either prose or poetry. The speaker chooses and practices the reading and delivers the piece using voice and facial expression to interpret the mood and meaning of the piece. It must be 5-7 minutes long.

Original Oratory

For original oratory, the speaker has prepared a 5-7 minute persuasive speech ahead of time on a topic of their choice.
