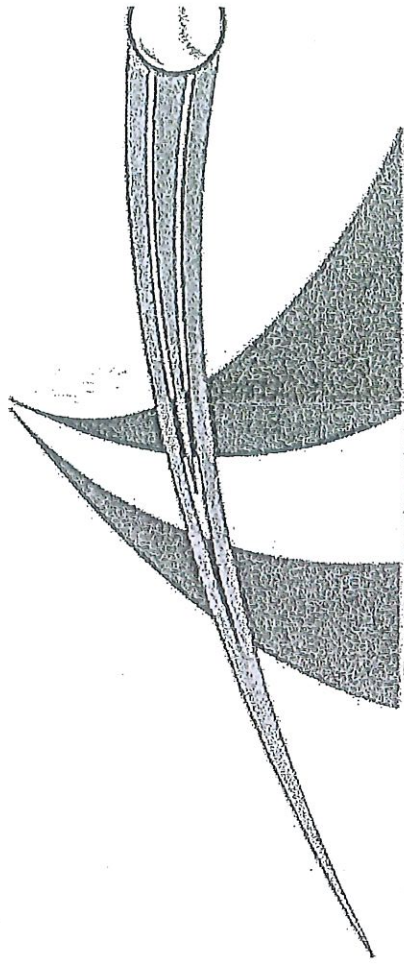

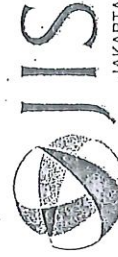

Dear Visiting Students and Parents,

Welcome to the IASAS Softball tournament. With hopes that your visits to our campus and wanderings throughout the tournament are pleasant and uncomplicated, we've decided to communicate the following:

Pedestrian access to the Cilandak Campus will be via Gate 1, located on JL. Terogong Raya. This main entrance is located up and over the hill from Hotel Kristal. Turn left as you leave the hotel. Take care with any handbag you carry, as bag snatching is an issue in Jakarta, as it is in any major city.

Parents, on your initial entry to campus, you will be asked to show a photo ID to JIS Security. You will be issued a Visitors Badge, which should be clipped to your clothing and made visible at all times. The Visitor Badge should be surrendered when you leave the campus.

In their visitor's pack, players will receive a Dragon Athletic Gate Pass. This pass is your temporary JIS ID. Please show it when passing through our security checkpoints.

The first and second stories of the Cilandak Campus Cafeteria or 'Wantilan', located in the center of our campus, will be open on Thursday and Friday, from 6:30 am to 8:00 pm and on Saturday, from 7:00 am to 10:00 pm. The bottom floor is open air. The second floor food court is air-conditioned.

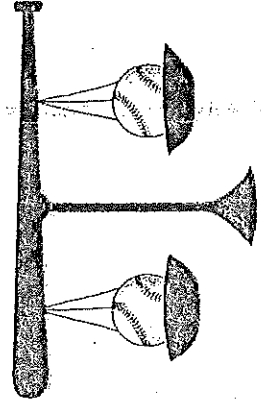

Medical Procedure

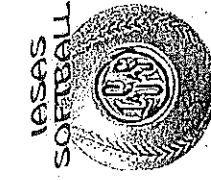
