If it is after school hours, they should contact either their host families or one of the tournament officials at their homes as listed in the program.

# IASAS BASKETBALL RULES

### I. RULES

A Rule Book:

F.I.B.A. (latest edition):

- B. Schools hosting basketball must have visible 24-second clocks. (10/01)
- C. The official ball is the Wilson Jet, Wide Channel. (10/02)

### II. RULE EXCEPTION

- A. Jump ball will only be used at the start of the game and overtime periods.
- B. An arrow set at the recorders' table will indicate which team next gains possession on subsequent jump ball situations.
- C. Recommended uniform numbers for IASAS will be 1-15, 21 25 (10/03).
- D. There will be no dunking during warm-up time before the games. The penalty will be a technical foul, with two shots awarded to the opposing team. (5/96)
- E. Half-time breaks will be 10 minutes. (4/03)

### III. ROSTERS

Rosters (up to ten boys and ten girls) must be submitted two weeks prior to the tournament and include the following information:

Two basketball courts are required. Both teams should have their pre-game warm-up in front of their bench, and the home team will face the clock in the second half. (5/96)

As specified in F.I.B.A. rules. Exception: A smaller women's basketball will be used for all IASAS women's tournament games. (5/93)

### **UNIFORMS**

All teams must have light and dark uniforms.

### **)FFICIALS**

- A. The source of officials is to be determined by the host school. Whenever possible, the host school should utilize host country international sporting pragnizations to officiate tournaments. Each game will have three officials. (10/03)
- 3. Translation services will need to be provided to ensure effective communication between host country and English speakers. (10/01)
- C. The official scorer must be an adult. (10/01)

### POST SELECTION PLAY

The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> ranked teams will play for 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

There will be no post section play for the  $5^{th}$  and  $6^{th}$  ranked teams.

# IASAS RULES & GUIDELINES

Smoking, drinking alcohol, drug abuse, cheating, deceit, flagrant curfew violations and violations of "off-limits" areas as well as aiding and abetting any of the above will not be permitted during any IASAS event (4/01)

Penalties for infractions are as follows:

- 1. Suspension from further participation in the event
- 2. A student will be sent home if feasible to do so
- 3. The student will be excluded from all IASAS events for 1 full year including the same event/convention time the following year
- 4. Additionally, students will not be legible for letters or awards for that activity
- 5. Each school will apply additional disciplinary action in compliance with its disciplinary code

Participants must notify coaches or hosts before leaving convention sites. Exploration of the local environment will not be permitted without the knowledge and consent of the host parent/guardian.

Under no circumstances may housing assignments be changed.

All tournament participants (housing or visiting) must return to the host families houses before 10:00pm each night. However, should an event finish later than one hour before the stated curfew, curfew will be extended until one hour after the conclusion of the event. Once a student is in and has answered the curfew call he/she may not leave the house.

All laws of the host country must be observed. Guidelines are to be provided by host schools as required.

No disciplinary action will be taken by the Tournament Director without direct communication with the respective coach/sponsor or trip administrator.

The host school will arrange transport to and from the airport as well as the convention site.

Any problem arising during the convention should be reported immediately to the host school for corrective measures.

Student medical release forms will be available at the convention site each day of the event.

All students must carry with them their IASAS Identification Cards.
