Roger Bannister became the first human being to run a sub four-minute mile, breaking the world record in 1954 with a time of 3:59.4. He did what others thought impossible. He did this while in medical school at Oxford University. The best part of the story is how Roger Bannister rose from the dust-heap of national disgrace. He was favored to win both the mile and 1,500-meter events in the 1952 Olympics in Helsinki. He performed poorly and suffered the scorn of the media and fellow countryman. His response was to keep training for the next two years. At the age of 25 Bannister broke the four-minute mile barrier and then did it again with a time of 3:58.9 – his personal best.

Of course we at the Taipei American School can only hope that in joining us this weekend you will achieve your personal best. Our TAS community wants you to have an exceptional experience in the coming days.

On behalf of our school community - with a special thanks to all the coaches, our TAS parents who are hosting you, our Parent Teacher Association who are always with us and support, Dave Farmer our Athletic Director and Kathy Cutler, our Activities Director - please accept my sincere welcome. We will do our very best to make this a great weekend for building relationships across IASAS schools. Taipei American School would like to give a special thanks to Ms. Chi Cheng who will be presenting the medals at the award ceremony on Saturday night.



Chi Cheng

Chi Cheng is considered by many to be the top Asian woman track and field athlete of the 20th century. She competed at three Olympics ('60, '64, '68) for the Republic of China (Taiwan), and won a bronze medal in the 80m hurdle event at Mexico City.

Chi trained for much of her career in the U.S., and competed while a student at Cal Poly Pomona. As a competitor at the Relays, she won a total of eight titles in three events: 100 and 220 yard dash, and 80m/100m hurdles.

It was in these three events that Chi tied or broke world records in 1970. Amazingly, all three marks came within a one week period. She equalled the 100m hurdle record, and broke the 200m record, on July 12, 1970 (a little more than one hour apart). On July 18, 1970, she broke the 100m record, running 11.0 seconds.

Chi appeared to be improving with age. She followed her Olympic medal in 1968 with a remarkable run of performances in 1969 and 1970. During this two year period, Chi won 153 of the 154 events (sprints, hurdles, long jump, relays) in which she competed. Unfortunately, an injury prevented her from competing at the 1972 Olympics.

After returning to Taiwan in 1980, Chi won election to three terms as a congresswoman in Taiwan's government. She also served as secretary-general of Taiwan's track and field

association, and as a member of the Olympic committee. She played a key role in marshaling support within Taiwan for China's successful bid to host the 2008 Olympics.
