CHARITY INFORMATION

IASAS T-shirts on stock are S\$20.00. Part of the proceeds from the t-shirts will go to the Stairway Foundation, a joint IASAS schools venture.

IASAS CHARITY 2003-2004

Stairway Foundation Inc. (SFI) is a non-profit, non-government child care institution licensed and accredited by the Philippine Government. The Foundation was established in 1993 with the assistance from Danish International Assistance (DANIDA). The founders of the program, who financed the initial developments and the first years of operation, are still part of the daily operation of the centre.

VISION

The vision is to see all children realize their abilities, hope and dreams in a society which will respect and protect their rights as human beings and will hold equality, justice, spirituality, health, education, family, community and the environment as the guiding values and principle for all development.

OUR PURPOSE

Stairway works for the promotion and the upholding of children's rights in accordance with the United Nation's Convention on the Rights of the Child. The approach is through a range of programs, which fall under the categories of advocacy, capacity building and service. Stairway Foundation's residential program offers therapy and education for particularly disadvantaged street children and children with serious health problems, such as tuberculosis.

REHABILITATION

At Stairway's residential centre we work with marginalized street children and youth from Manila. They are beggars, scavengers, prostitutes, solvent users, drug addicts, sexually abused children, youth offenders and children with serious health problems.

As children stay longer on the streets, they immerse deeper into its' subculture. Their problems take another dimension and become even more urgent and complicated. Innovative programs are needed to break the contact between the child and the streets and to facilitate the process of rehabilitation and education, which is necessary to successfully reintegrate the child back into society.

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

For our residential care program we provided 24 hours services to 32 youth. All underwent art therapy, non-formal or formal schooling skills training, CRC and Child Sexual Abuse Prevention Education, counseling and spiritual formation.

CREATIVE ADVOCACY

Advocacy is not the most tangible vehicle to help the millions of children living on the streets under extremely difficult circumstances. It is however, only through advocacy that we can mobilize the force of public opinion, which is needed to make a change in the social and economic structures that are largely to blame for massive violations of children's rights.

Stairway uses the arts as a means to confront, debate and to campaign the issues of marginalized children and youth around the world.

IASAS SWIMMING RULES

I. RULES

A. Rule Book:

B. General Rules:

1. There will be preliminaries and finals in all events except the:

- 400m. individual medley;
- 800m. freestyle;
- 4 x 100m. medley relay; and
- 4 x 100m. freestyle relay

For these exceptions there will be timed finals.

2. If, because of the small numbers of entries, heats are not required, then swimmers will automatically advance to the finals without preliminaries. If this should happen, then that final will be swum as a timed final.

II. ENTRIES

- Entries will be limited to four (4) entries per event per school for individual events, and one (1) entry per school per relay. All schools must send in their final entries one week (7 days) before the IASAS Meet, with the exception of relays.
- Swimmers may compete in up to five (5) events but no more than four (4) individual events.
- Entries made on Meet Manager, or compatible system, and confirmation of those entries must be sent back to each school with no indication of seeding (list the event and time only).
- No entries will be entered as a "no time-NT".
- Coaches must submit the names for relay teams, with two alternates and a time, 30 minutes after the conclusion of the morning's events. Times would be used for seeding, but not released by meet management to coaches. The final 4 names with time must be submitted at the start of the 15 minute warm-up preceding the event. Team names and times will be released to all coaches at that time.

III. SCRATCHES

A complete meet program for all three days is prepared for distribution at the Wednesday evening coaches' meeting, but no changes are allowed after program is distributed. Changes must be made before the program is passed out. Changes during the meet will only be allowed in case of injury of illness with nurse or doctor verification.

IV. SEEDING

- Lanes for the preliminary rounds will be seeded according to times submitted and according to F.I.N.A. procedures.
- For the finals, swimmers will be assigned lanes according to the times swum in the heats, from the fastest to slowest, in this order:

VI. DISQUALIFICATION

- The athlete and coach must be notified of the disqualification with a full explanation immediately after he/she finishes the event, preferably while he/she is still in the water. A copy of the Disqualification Sheet should be given to the coach within 10 minutes after the heat and before the results have been posted.
- It is recommended that relay starts need dual confirmation for disqualification.
- No points or medals will be awarded for places lost to disqualifications.
